again

13 qualify for UIL academic regionals

The high school University Interscholastic League academic team captured the district 29 AA championship for the fifth consecutive year as 13 students qualified for the regional contest in 18 events during the past week.

BHS students finished with 406 points toward their sweepstakes win.

Stockdale and Randolph were over 100 points behind with 272 and 224, respectively. Other point totals included Poth—127, Navarro—135, and Cole—141.

Bryan Weber placed in five events and was responsible for 51 of Blanco's points. Scooter Farmer scored 41 points in four events, and Eric Tschetter was responsible for 31 points in three events.

"I was pleased to see that we scored points in 18 of 22 events. This shows that we have a balanced program," said high school UIL coordinator James Caudell. "Many of our speakers also placed in writing and math events." Below is a list of participants and winners.
