The Blanco High School Academic Team captured its sixth straight district title as members outdistanced their nearest competition by 110 points at the 29AA district meet held at BHS during the week of March 27-31.

Blanco students scored 373 points. Stockdale was second with 263 points. Point totals of other schools in the district were: Cole-237, Randolph-182, Poth-133, and Navarro-116.

Students who finished in first, second, and third place qualified for the Region IV Academic Meet at Southwest Texas State University on April 14-15. A team must place first to qualify for the regional contest.

Senior Brett Mouser, already a state champion in CX debate this year, led the team with a total of 40 points. He qualified for the regional meet in three events.

CX Debaters Take First and Second at UIL State Meet

Who *really* won will always remain a mystery, but...

Brett Mouser and Eric Tschetter defeated Alan Barrington and Drake Mikeska as Blanco High School teams finished in first and second place at the University Interscholastic League Class AA State Cross-Examination Debate Tournament on March 13-14 at the University of Texas in Austin.

Two teams from the same school finishing first and second in the state has only occurred nine times in the 90-year history of the UIL.

BHS took the first four places at the District 29AA tournament on February 21, with the two top teams finishing in the same position in district as they did at the state tournament. Sophomores Candace Minjares and Jessica McLachlan took third and freshmen Eva Wolchover and Garlyn Schwarzlose placed fourth.

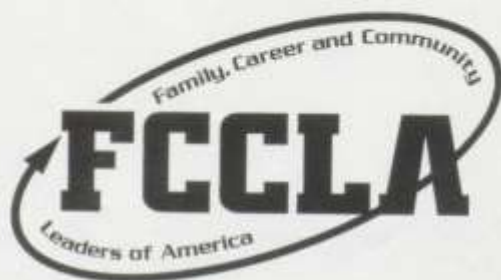

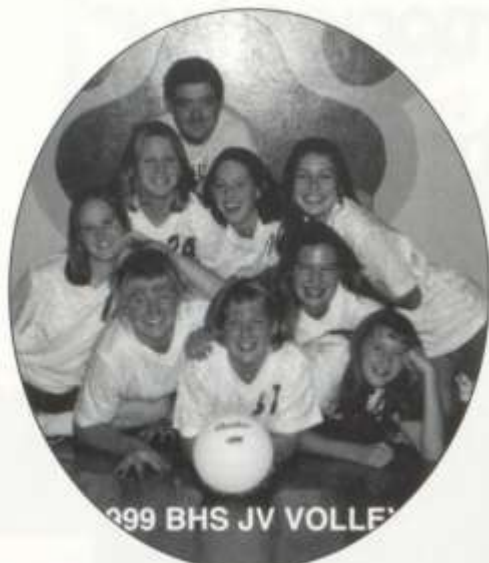

Mia Hamm and Brandi Chastain lead the team in a 5-4 narrow, penalty-kick victory over China to win the Women's World Cup.

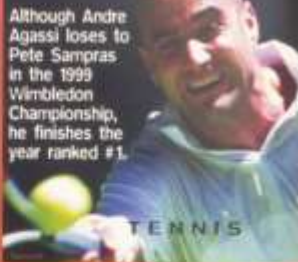

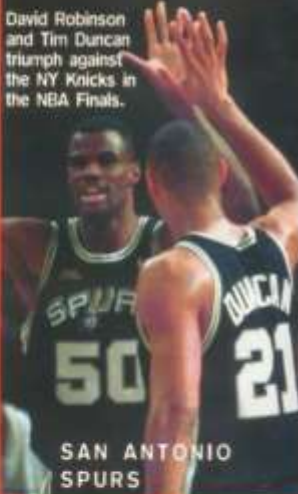

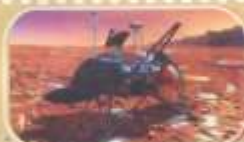

These cool cowgirls continue to enjoy the success of their breakthrough album "Wide Open Spaces."

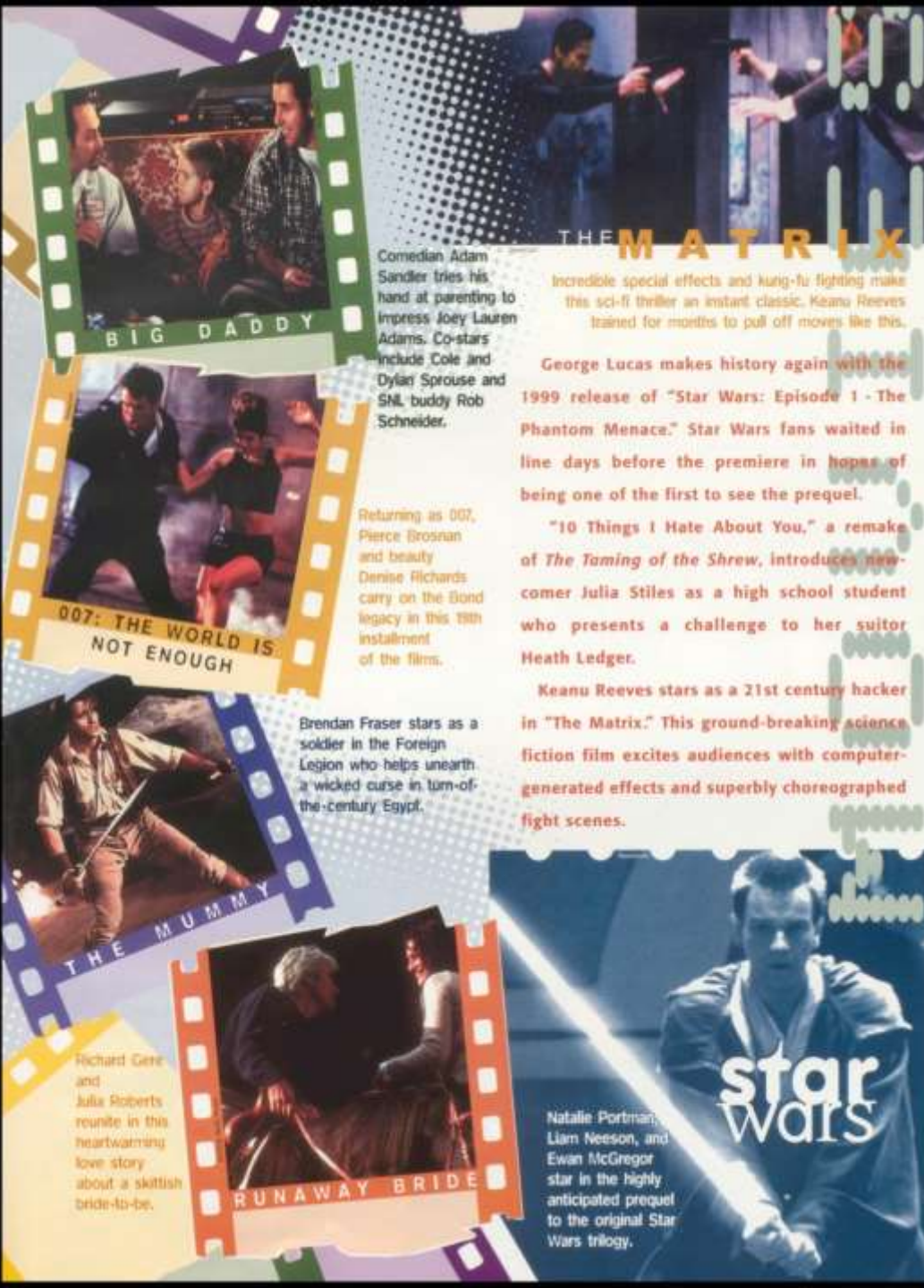

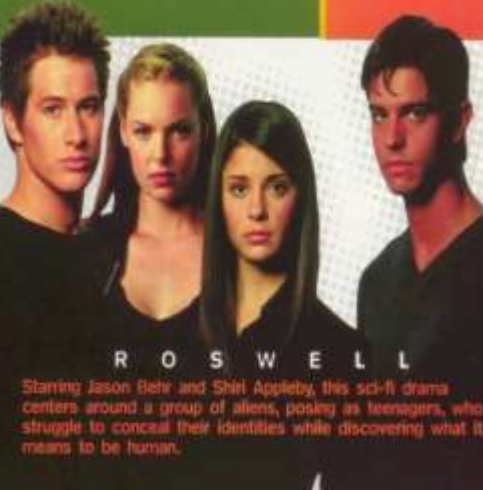
