Natalie has been active in speech, debate, and academics and has qualified for the UIL State Meet five times in three different events. This year Natalie became the state champion in Lincoln-Douglas debate, as well as winning the regional and district championships. As a junior, she was a regional champion and state bronze medalist in Lincoln-Douglas debate. She also qualified for the state tournament in feature writing and ready writing. Natalie has accumulated over 750 points as a member of the National Forensic League. She was also a member of the National Honor Society, and a Student Council class representative for three years. During her freshman year, Natalie played volleyball and tennis, placing third at district in varsity tennis and playing on the team that qualified for team tennis state.
