Ben Rehder's love of the outdoors has influenced much of his writing, including his Blanco

'County comic mysteries revolving around a Texas game warden and a colorful cast of rural characters. Novels from that series have made best-of-the-year lists in Publishers Weekly, Library Journal, Kirkus Reviews, and Field & Stream. Buck Fever, the first in the series, was a finalist for the Edgar Award for Best First Novel from the Mystery Writers of America. Get Busy Dying, the second novel in Rehder's Roy Ballard mystery series, was a finalist for the Shamus Award. Rehder's standalone novel, The Chicken Hanger, won the Texas Philosophical Society's Award of Merit in 2013. Rehder lives with his wife near Austin, where he was born and raised.
