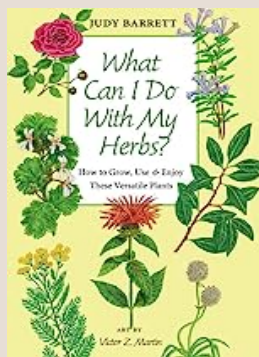

Using the fruit produced on the estate itself, and supplemented with Texas High Plains fruit, the winery has produced six varietals with multiple vintages, providing a unique wine tasting experience in the Texas Hill Country. Tastings are available at 115 Main Street in Blanco. In 2023, Esperanza Winery was voted Best Local Winery and Best Vineyard or Winery Tour & Tasting in the Best of Blanco County contest.
